The only news Mutti has from me is a card from August 25. Am sure she is very worried and would have been happy to have received my letter 48 hours earlier. Because of the censor, all letters have to be short, clear and distinct. Jokes, like Arabic words are not to appear, because they can be interpreted differently. We can only correspond with Mutti or Gusti via a neutral country, and I have to entrust you with the mailing of letters. So please execute it with intelligence and promptness. I know very well, that this last delay is not alone your fault, and I don't want to offend you or Gretli. I love you both very much, you are very dear children and it will not happen again and we will continue to love each other terribly much and firmly support each other.
